Episode 10: Blood and Singing

In Revelation 14:14-20, you've got reapers and grapes and blood and wrath. Write a sentence or two, and explain how those four things relate to each other.

Chapters 15 and 16 are, like other chapters in Revelation, filled with songs. Use the following chart to put them in their places next to each other:

What do the bloody water (16:3-4), the fire from the sky (16:8-9), the darkness (16:10), the frogs (16:13), and the hail (16:21) remind you of? What message is God communicating in these echoes?

As chapter 16 wraps up, what messages does God repeatedly send to Israel in their distress?
